Specifying QoR in a meaningful way is hard (granularity? ref point?)

Guaranteeing is hard (cost? missing information?)

Debugging is hard (where is my bug? too approximate?)

Approximate: relaxing accuracy (det/nondet)

Probabilistic: computing with probabilities
